What is Quality of Feedback?

Quality of Feedback captures how teachers provide feedback focused on expanding children’s learning and understanding versus correctness.

5 Quality of Feedback Indicators:

- ★ 1. **Scaffold** children’s learning to help them arrive at an answer or response.
2. Create **Feedback Loops** by having back & forth conversations.
3. **Prompting Thought Processes** by asking students to explain their thinking.
4. **Provide Information** that clarifies or gives specific feedback.
5. Provide **Encouragement and Affirmation** so children feel supported and motivated to keep learning.
