	<h1>KNOW</h1>	<p>What is Quality of Feedback?</p> <p>Quality of Feedback assesses the degree to which teachers' responses to what children say and/or do promotes learning and understanding and expands children's participation.</p> <p>3 Quality of Feedback Indicators:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> ★ 1. Follow up on children's actions or comments with hints, assistance, or prompting that Scaffolds their understanding. 2. Provide Information that clarifies or expands children's understanding. 3.
